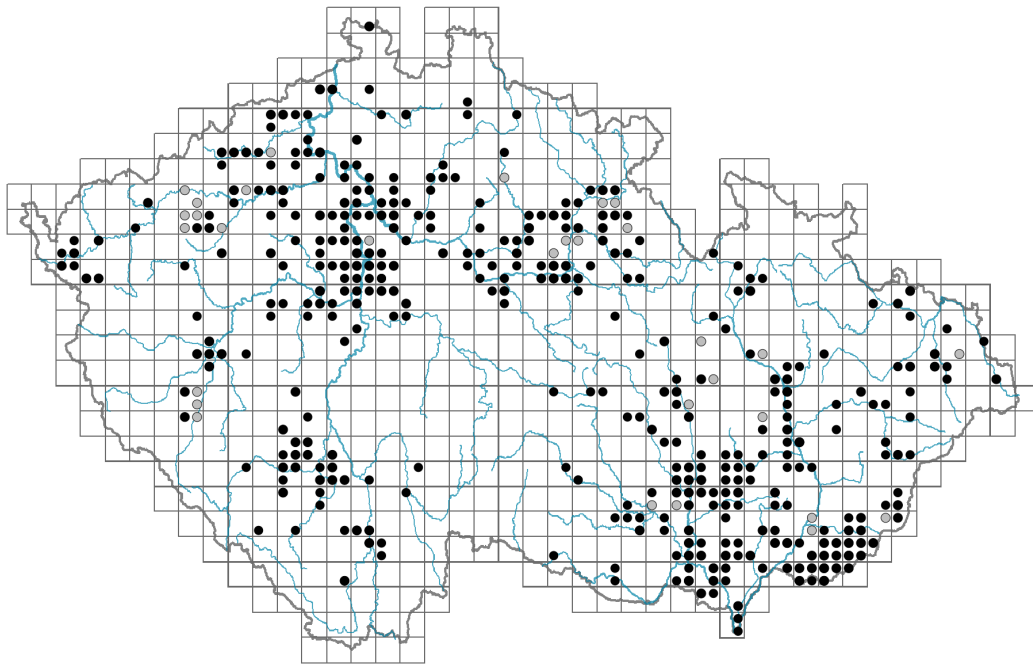


Bromus racemosus agg.

Habitus and growth type

Height [m]: **0.2-1**

Growth form: **annual herb**

Life form: **hemicryptophyte, therophyte**

Life strategy: **C - competitor, CR - competitor/ruderal**

Leaf arrangement (phyllotaxis): **alternate**

Leaf shape: **simple - entire**

Flower

Flowering period [month]: **May-June**

Flowering phase: **6 Cornus sanguinea-Melica uniflora (start of early summer), 8 Clematis vitalba-Galium sylvaticum (mid-summer)**

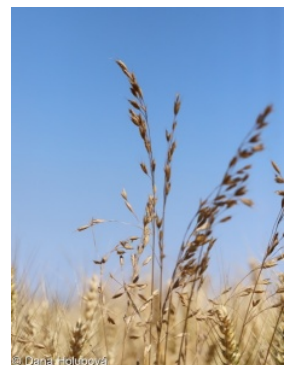
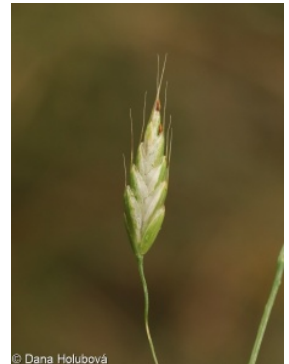
Ecological indicator values

Ellenberg-type indicator values

Light indicator value: **7 - half-light plant, mostly occurring at full light, but also in the shade up to about 30% of diffuse radiation incident in an open area**

Temperature indicator value: **6 - transition between values 5 and 7**

Moisture indicator value: **8 - transition between values 7 and 9**



Reaction indicator value: **6 - transition between values 5 and 7**

Nutrient indicator value: **5 - occurring at moderately nutrient-rich sites, and less frequently at poor and rich sites**

Salinity indicator value: **1 - salt tolerant, mostly on low-salt to salt-free soils, but occasionally on slightly salty soils**

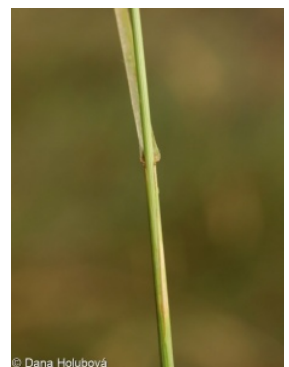
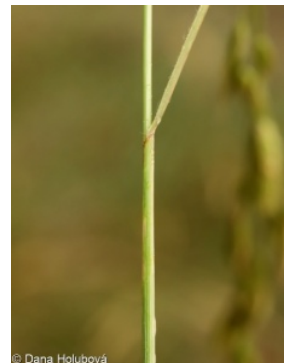

Affinity to the forest environment in Thermophyticum: **0 - taxon that does not spontaneously occur in Czech forests**

Affinity to the forest environment in Mesophyticum and Oreophyticum: **0 - taxon that does not spontaneously occur in Czech forests**

Floristic region: **Europe**
