Height [m]: **1-6**

Growth form: **clonal herb**

Life form: **therophyte**

Leaf

Leaf presence and metamorphosis: **leaves present, not modified**

Leaf arrangement (phyllotaxis): **alternate, opposite**

Leaf shape: **simple - palmately divided**

Stipules: **present**

Petiole: **present**

Flower

Flowering period [month]: **July-September**

Flower colour: **green**

Flower symmetry: **actinomorphic**

Perianth type: **homochlamydeous, sometimes reduced**

Perianth fusion: **free, reduced**

Inflorescence type: **capitulum e floribus masculis compositum, panicula e floribus masculis composita**

Generative reproduction type: **allogamy**
