


# *Sarracenia purpurea*

## Habitus and growth type

Height [m]: **0.2-0.8**

Life form: **hemicryptophyte**

Life strategy (Pierce method based on leaf traits): **C/CR**

Life strategy (Pierce method, C-score): **65.4 %**

Life strategy (Pierce method, S-score): **15.7 %**

Life strategy (Pierce method, R-score): **18.9 %**

## Leaf

Leaf presence and metamorphosis: **leaves modified to pitchers**

Leaf arrangement (phyllotaxis): **rosulate**

Leaf shape: **simple - entire**

Stipules: **absent**

## Flower

Flowering period [month]: **June-July**

Flower colour: **red-violet**

Flower symmetry: **actinomorphic**

Perianth type: **calyx and corolla**

Perianth fusion: **free**

Calyx fusion: **aposepalous**

Inflorescence type: **flores solitarii**

## Fruit, seed and dispersal

Fruit type: **dry fruit - capsule**

Myrmecochory: **non-myrmecochorous (b)**

Parasitism and mycoheterotrophy: **autotrophic**

Affinity to the forest environment

Affinity to the forest environment in Thermophyticum: **0 - taxon that does not spontaneously occur in Czech forests**

Affinity to the forest environment in Mesophyticum and Oreophyticum: **0 - taxon that does not spontaneously occur in Czech forests**

## Threats and protection

Red List 2017 (national categories): **taxon is not on the Red List**

Red List 2017 (IUCN categories): **LC(NA) - least concern (taxon is not on the Red List)**

Legal protection: **not protected by law**
